## THE DEITY OF CHRIST-1

The Bible leaves no doubt about the answer to the question "Who is Jesus Christ?". It declares in many places that Christ is GOD in the most absolute and infinite sense of that word. One should not only know that the Bible teaches that Jesus Christ is God, but he should be able to prove it.

### A. The Attributes of Christ Prove that He is God

Paul says of Christ, "... in him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily" (Col. 2:9). How much stronger can language be? The apostle here indicated that everything that can be said about God, all His

attributes and power, are also true of Jesus Christ. These perfections have their significance in that they are peculiar to God and absent in all others, then it must be evident at once that if Christ possessed the attributes of God, He could be nothing less than God!

#### 1. Omniscience

In Colossians 2: 3 Paul says of Christ, "In whom (in Christ) are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge." (John 1:48; 2: 24,25; 4:50; 11:4; Mark 2: 6-8). Consider these facts: Jesus Christ was never confused, never surprised, never mistaken, knew both the past and the future without having to be told and taught from a

treasury of knowledge that was inexhaustible.

#### 2. Omnipotence

Jesus Christ displayed all power over sickness, death and nature while here on earth. John's Gospel was built around seven of Christ's miracles, and they are the sufficient proof of His omnipotence (See John 20:30,31). The One who created everything with His omnipotence controls everything with the same power (John 1:3; Heb. 1:3). Jesus Christ also claimed that He is Sovereign and Omnipotent (Matthew 28:18; Rev. 1:8).

#### 3. Omnipresence

Jesus claimed omnipresence when talking to Nicodemus

Hospitality was an ancient respectful and approved sign of friendship seen in the families and various countries. It is seen in the Bible from beginning to end and was very important for the Israelites who wandered in the desert. Jacob said to Pharaoh 'The days of the years of my 'pilgrimage' are one hundred and forty years'. In Heb 13:1 apostle Paul reminds us not to forget the hospitality. In 1Pet 4:9 Apostle Peter says to continue in hospitality. Right from the book of Genesis hospitality is seen in many places. Abraham, Lot, Manoha, Samuel and David received angels. Laban received Abraham's servant and Jacob. Joseph received his brothers sincerely. Reguel's reception of Moses who fled away from Egypt changed his life. Hospitality is a specialty at all times. Solomon received Sheba in all his royal prestige. But the families received receive the guest in the manner suitable for them.

But for a child of God hospitality is not a mere practice. It is an outward appearance of love, care and fellowship. When a guest is at home it is the duty of the host to take care of his needs. In the history we see the guest are

met at near the well and city gates. People used to wait at such places for a host. (Ex19:1, Jud 19:5). Once they are received they and their animals will be well treated by the hosts. There is not much difference in the custom even now. Water, ointment and a hug are the parts of the hospitality very often. Lord received sincere hospitality frequently at the houses of Pharisees, Martha, Zachias and Simon.

Apostle Paul and his companions got welcome in the houses of Lydia, Jailer, and Joseph. Now this hospitality should be shown to all believers and evangelists. Financial support is to be given to the needy people by the believers. But beware of the false teachers and false prophets who enter in to the houses. Hospitality is the important work of a church leader. (1 Ti 3:2, Tit 1:8, 1 Pet 4:9, He 13:1&2). Let the brotherly love continue. Do not forget to entertain the strangers, by doing so some have unwittingly entertained angels. Let us pray that our assemblies and individuals may be very much interested in hospitality. May the name of our Lord be glorified by doing so.

who, being a student of the Bible, would at once recognize the claim for deity inherent in such a statement (John 3:13). This verse makes it clear that when He was making this statement from earth, He was also present at heaven.

Now Jesus Christ is seated at the right hand of God the father in heaven; at the same time He is in our midst and He is with us (Matthew 18:20; 28:20). The very fact that Jesus Christ is present in heaven and earth at the same time is a clear proof that Jesus Christ is God.

## **4. Eternity**

The pre-existence of Christ is clearly taught in the scriptures. It means, Jesus Christ existed before He was born in Bethlehem. But there is a difference between pre-existence and eternity. Eternity means that not only did Jesus Christ exist before He was incarnate in flesh, but that He had no beginning at all; He always was! Something

may be created and still have pre-existence. Only God can possess eternity (cf. Mic. 5: 2; John 1:1; 8:56-58; John 12:38-41; Rev. 1: 8).

## **5. Immutability**

Just as the Bible attributes this changelessness to God (Mal. 3: 6), so with equal clarity it is attributed to Jesus Christ (Heb. 1:1-12; 13: 8).

## **6. Freedom**

Even when subjecting Himself to the will of the Father and to the cruelty of men, Jesus Christ displayed the attribute of absolute freedom. He was free to do as He pleased, and it pleased Him to submit (Phil. 2:6-8; John 10:17,18; Matt. 26: 53,54).

## **7. Holiness**

In Hebrews 7: 26 we read that, "..... such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens." The angel of a n n u n c i a t i o n recognized His holiness (Luke 1: 35) as did

Satan (Mark 1: 24). Jesus Christ challenged, "Which one of you convicts me of sin?" (John 8:46). No body was there to give a proper answer.

## **8. Love**

As in the case of Christ's holiness it is not enough to show that Christ loved, but it must be shown that Christ loved equally with and to the same degree as God the Father. This is the point which demonstrates the infinity of Christ's love and shows that He could be nothing less than God. (cf. Eph. 5:2; 2 Cor. 5:14; Gal. 2:20.) Thus it is seen that whatever the Bible predicates in respect to God it does likewise in respect to Jesus Christ indicating that He could be no less than Very God of Very God. It is of utmost importance to hold this fact clearly in mind. The truth that should be proclaimed even by giving the life - **"Jesus Christ is the TRUE GOD."**

## **Is Kerala a Lunatic Asylum?**
