starts to see these sites. The children at the age of 12 to 17 take more interest to visit these sites. What is the after effect of this? We should be aware of this. Children will become quite and prefer loneliness. They spend time in day dreams. They loose their self motivation and ability. And live in a feeling of guilt. They curse themselves for every thing. Is there any redemption from this bondage? The Bible says YES. In Rom 13:14 says make no provision for flesh to fulfill its lusts. Make good friends (1Cor 15:33). Do not exhibit the love physically. Avoid the temptations. (Gen 39:12). Do not become the slaves of the circumstances. (Eph5:15). Watch and pray lest you enter in to temptation (Mark 14:38). Remember that we have to give account for everything (Rom 13:12).

2. Mobile Phones.
This has become the highest in usage. India has got the 2nd place in the usage of mobile phones. According to the study of 2009, 40.3 million people are using mobile phones. A university survey report shows that people will report the loss of a purse within 26 hours, mean time they report the loss of a mobile phone within 68 minutes. A life without mobile phones has become impossible. A global survey reports that 60% of the people sleep with the mobile. The usages of the mobile phones are many. The parents can locate the children. It can be used as a calculator, telephone directory, electronic game, camera, messenger or a music player. But on the other hand it causes head and mouth cancer, deafness and other health problems. The social problems are much more

serious. The children always sit in their private rooms. They cut short the communication with their parents. Once one mother said like this" there is no time to talk with my son since he is always in his private room". The tension in the children will increase and they start stealing for recharge coupons. Since they talk many hours in the night, they get up very late and get away from the family prayer. Some people bring the phone for the worship meetings and play games during the time of word ministry. The psychologists say that the mobile phones are the greatest addiction of the 21st century. The schools have stopped the use of mobiles. What about the churches? The traffic rules are against the use of mobiles while driving. What restrictions are given to the children by parents? Are the

parents neglecting the bad consequences?

3. Television.
The purpose of the Television is to listen for the world news. But in many houses the TV is working for many hours. This shows the influence of the TV. Years before parents used to switch of the TV when some ugly advertisements are shown. But today the serials are watched in presence of children. This will cause much damage to the spiritual life of the children. They can not read Bible or pray with concentration. The children those who watch TV late in the night will have this problem. This will create much problem in their spiritual life.

4. Smoking and drinking.
Smoking and drinking are harmful for the health.

The poisonous ingredients will destroy many of the brain cells. The temporary relief will create much more complicated problems in future. Many start these bad habits by the influence of their friends and finally they become addicts to alcohol and smoking. Finally they fell in to depression and guilt. Our body belongs to God and we are only the caretakers. God wants His temple to be holy and those who destroy His temple, He will destroy. (1Cor 6:19, 20). So it is our responsibility to keep the temple of God holy.

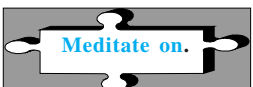

She was restricted in the house without able to go anywhere outside. What a cruelty was showed by the enemies to this girl!! After few years, she saw a beggar standing outside the gate of her house. She recognized him immediately. She understood that he was that cruel man who cut her hands. She said to the people who were there in her house to give enough bread and milk to the man. She watched him while he was eating it. He ate the full food impatiently. When he was finished eating she removed the glows that were on her hands to cover the wounds. By raising her broken hands she said loudly like this, “I repaid! I Repaid! He understood everything. We should see

the shameful reactions on his face at that moment. She repaid to those who did evil to her by doing good. If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink (Rom.12:20). Love him. Pray for him. These are the good things that the Bible tells us to do for him. But today the ones who are becoming the enemies are our brothers, some members in our assembly or our neighbors. Do we have the same response that the girl showed? Does the scripture have any influence in our lives? Does our flesh advise us to take revenge in the best possible way when we get the right time? We are not hearing the gentle sound of goodness of the spirit. If the God’s spirit is abiding in us, let us repay by doing good like the girl. Those who are controlled by God’s love can do this. Repay is not for us.
