Forsake All for Christ

While presenting the conditions of true discipleship, the Lord Jesus declared in no uncertain terms that we have to forsake all for Christ to be His true disciples. Let's listen to His words: "So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple" (Luke 14:33). Hard saying? Yes, in the first hearing. Impractical? No. Probably, this is one of the very unpopular verses in the New Testament and something that is not understood accurately.

What does our Lord really mean by this condition? Is it something possible? Is it not contrary to the general teaching of the New Testament? Hundreds of such questions will rise in our minds when we read His words. To discover the correct meaning of this

condition for discipleship we have to examine other passages in the Scripture too. Since the Bible never contradicts itself, this verse must be understood in the light of other passages dealing with similar issues.

The first question we have to answer is this: Does this condition teach asceticism? The answer is an emphatic No. In fact, the Bible condemns an ascetic life imposed on others (1Tim. 4:2-4). In addition to that the Bible commands and always commends family life. As far as we know all the apostles except Paul were family men (1Corinthians 9:5). Therefore, by the expression, "forsake all", our Lord never meant His disciples to forsake their family life. Does this condition of discipleship prohibit ownership of private property and saving

for our present and future needs? The answer again is an emphatic No. Let's survey the plain teaching of the Bible in this regard:

"... the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children" (2Cor.12:14). The Bible commands the parents to save for their children.

"But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever" (1Tim.5:8) Here Paul denounces those who do not provide for their household.

..... If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat" (2Thess. 3:10). The practical principle laid down here is that one

So nobody showed any interest to listen to the message or songs and also to buy any books. Usually the people of North India gather together to us when they hear the songs. The Brethren Community Falling in to the Sharp Claws of the Imperialists?

The inner meaning in some of the advertisements which has appeared in some of our publications recently should not be ignored. The Brethren Assembly in Kerala has crossed 100 plus. The YMEF was formed approximately 40 years after the formation of the Brethren Assembly in Kerala. The main purpose of the YMEF was the growth of the local assemblies, edification of the saints and evangelisation. This movement was not started for any personal gains or personal motives. No selfish and personal motives were behind it in the beginning of the YMEF. Even today it remains the same by the grace of the Lord. Many other organisations came in to existence later on for common interest. They all continue for the benefit of the brethren community in general. The audited accounts of them itself is a clear cut manifestation of it and the transparency of the account of them are commentable. But the spiritual men can discern the motives behind the personal trust and ministries which came in to being because of the inflow of the foreign funds. Most of them are for personal gains and selfish motives. The funds for the aid of the saints should be through the local assembly or general funds like KEMF or BRT, when the distribution is done by personal ministries the way and means may not be proper and cannot be justified. Many may not be able to handle it faithfully. Moreover such distributors will be little godsthe donor when the real donor is some where in the world who will never be in the picture. Even the evangelisation programme is also under the evil influence of money.

Dear saints think about this under the proper guidance of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord enable everyone to take a proper decision according the Our Lords will and according to the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

***Editorial* THE IMPORTANCE OF LOCAL ASSEMBLIES**

The New Testament has given very importance for the local assemblies. The last message of our Lord given to Apostle John is written in the book of Revelation. Lord gives separate messages to the 7 local Churches those were present in those days (Rev 2&3). Our Lord only used the word 'Church' first time (Mat 16:18). Approximately 106 times we can the word Church in the New Testament. The last usage of the word is seen in Rev 22:16, "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the Churches, ———". We should not forget that the Church has got very important role in God's plan.

Some evangelist will keep on visiting other assemblies on Sundays and will be present in their parent assembly only very rarely. This is not a good practice. An evangelist has to keep permanent fellowship with his parent assembly. We have a great responsibility towards our own assemblies and the evangelists have more. And they and youngsters should be submissive to the elders (1Pet 5:5). Every thing in the Church will not be according to their will and pleasure. God has entrusted the elders to pasture the sheep (1Pet 5:2). An evangelist should work as per the guidance of the Church. The church has the responsibility to support the evangelist in all respect. This is the order seen in the scripture. The church of Antioch prayed and sent Paul and Barnabas for the first missionary journey (Acts 13:3). They came back and gave report to the same assembly (Acts 14:27). Especially the young evangelist should be very submissive to the elders so that they can learn the practices of the local Churches and will get the practical knowledge of solving the day to day problems. A young evangelist once went to north India for the gospel work after his graduation at a Bible college. But he failed in his career due to the lack of practical knowledge and finally he chose a secular job for survival. The group work should not be a hindrance for the assembly. Recently there is a complaint heard that the organizations are controlling the Churches. This should not happen. The assemblies are to be edified by all group works. YMEF is a good example for this. All camps of the northern division are completed by Saturday afternoon. So young brothers can go back to their parent assemblies on Sundays and do their duties. During the first meeting of YMEF at Kuriyannoor in 1941 Bro. M.E.Cheryan wrote like this "The activities of the local assemblies are very less on recent days. So the young people have to work with the guidance of the local assemblies. Restart the Sunday school classes, prepare a Sunday school syllabus, visit all church members to encourage them spiritually and conduct Bible camps to encourage young people for gospel work and spiritual values. These were the main decisions made in that gathering".

In Eph 1:23 we read that the church is the body of the glorified Christ. From the day of Pentecost to the 2nd coming of Christ all saved people are included in the church. We are not supposed to do any activity against the church that fades the importance of the church. The church is very important for Christ, which He has purchased by His own blood. Let all our activities to be for the edification of the church. If anybody does anything against the church, God will deal severally to that person. Let us work above our ability with the knowledge of the power of the church and with much fear for its benefit, so that the CHURCH will grow. Let God help us for that work.

should work and earn his food.

"Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, not to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy (1Tim. 6:17). Here Paul recognizes that there are certain rich disciples in the Church. Paul is not asking them to divest themselves of their riches. Instead commanding them not to trust in their riches, but to trust in God who is the giver of riches. He also writes that God has given all riches for our enjoyment too.

"The wise man saves for the future, but the foolish man spends whatever he gets" (Prov. 21:20 - The Living Bible). The wise man in the book of Proverbs is a godly man (Prov. 1: 7).

Sometimes Acts 2:45 is quoted to support that the Bible teaches all believers should give up their private property. John Mac Arthur Jr. makes an illuminating comment about this verse based on the original meaning of this verse: The verbs "sold" and "parted" are both in the imperfect tense, which means it was a continuous action... It simply means that all the believers were selling their goods and giving money to those who had need as the needs arose. It was a picture of self-sacrifice for the need of another, not of pooling everything. Nowhere does the Bible advocate that all money be put into a common pot to be dolled out by some hierarchy".
